All new students to Fairview and incoming second graders and their parents are welcome to join us on *Tuesday, August 7th from 6:30 – 7:30 p.m.* to learn more about Fairview and tour the building. We will meet in the **Multi Purpose Room** for a brief presentation to give you information about getting ready for the first days of school, and then you are invited to take a self-directed tour of the building to help your child learn his or her way around before starting on August 14th. Your attendance is not required, but we encourage you to join us to help your child to become more comfortable with Fairview. Any incoming second graders who ordered their school supplies through the PTO last spring can pick them up at this event.

Sometime after 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 8th, you will be receiving an email with a link and password where class lists will be posted. **For security reasons, we are no longer posting class lists in the foyer at Fairview as we have done in the past.**

PTO Back-to-School Picnic and School Supply Pick-Up

The Fairview PTO will be hosting a Back-to-School Picnic on Monday, August 13th from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. (see flyer enclosed for more details about this exciting event). Please bring your family and a picnic dinner, and join us for a time to celebrate the start of a new school year. School supplies will be available to be picked up in the gym at any time during the picnic as well. We hope to see you there!

Back-to-School Night: This year's Back-to-School Night will be held on Thursday, August 16th. Back-to-School Night is an event where parents will have the opportunity to hear from their child's classroom teacher about the upcoming school year. Please see the enclosed program for further information regarding the schedule for the event, and mark your calendars accordingly.

Registration

If you haven't done so already, please take the time to register your children for this coming school year. The information you give us during the registration process, including current contact information and emergency contact information, is extremely important for us to have heading into a new school year. *Parents who have not registered will not receive* classroom teacher assignments until the process has been completed. Registration is required to receive bussing information from the district as well. Please call the Fairview front office if you have questions about the registration process at 847-394-7320, as we are happy to help.

Drop-off/Pick-up Times and Procedures/Review of the First Day

For our first day of school, Fairview staff and PTO volunteers will join together to help students find their appropriate classroom line and entry door. These doors are located next to the bus turnaround on the northeast side of the building. Please instruct your child to talk to an adult if they need help finding where to go in the morning. If you plan to walk your child up to find his or her line, consider parking a few blocks away and walking to Fairview. There are some parking restrictions around the school and there will be more traffic than usual around the building on the first few days of school. Crossing guards are posted on the corners of Gregory and Fairview, Isabella and Fairview and at the front entrance to help students safely cross the front driveway. Busses will drop students off in the bus turnaround next to the area where students line up. There are no cars allowed in the bus turnaround. Any student who enters the front entrance should walk through the school and out a back door to line up with their classmates. If you have any questions on the first day, do not hesitate to ask the office. In terms of timing, please follow the schedule below. The first day of school is a full school day.

8:35 am - Fairview staff supervision and crossing guards report to their posts. If you arrive before 8:35 am your child will not be supervised.

8:45 am – Student entry bell

8:50 am – School day begins. On a typical day, students should be in their classrooms at this time. A tardy will be given to students if they are not in their classroom at 8:50 am. If you arrive late, please have your child report to the office for a tardy slip. The grade level doors by the bus turnaround lock at 8:50 am, and students will be required to enter through the main entrance at that time.

11:50 am – 4th and 5th grade lunch begins. 2nd and 3rd grade recess begins. **12:20 pm** – 2nd and 3rd grade lunch begins. 4th and 5th grade recess begins.

3:20 pm - End of the school day. Students are dismissed.

Please review the attached map for instructions on student drop-off and pick-up procedures and to locate your child's grade level door for morning lineup.

Absence Calling

In the event that your child will be absent from school, please call the front office at 847-394-7320 and press #1 when prompted. Attendance in school is of vital importance to the learning needs of our students, so please make every effort to have your children in school when they are healthy. Thank you for your help!

Kids' Corner

The first day of Kids' Corner before and after school care will take place on Tuesday, August 14th with the start of the school year. Kids' Corner drop-off and pick-up is located on your left as you go through the main entrance doors.
