

### DISTRICT 57 EDUCATION FOUNDATION

The District 57 Education Foundation is a non-profit organization comprised of Mount Prospect community members whose mission is to raise money to fund grants in the areas of curriculum, wellness, STEM and technology. Grant requests may be written and submitted by district teachers, staff, and parents. The grants enrich the educational experiences of all students, helping them to achieve at their highest potential. ## **I**Instructions

Read aloud: Let's answer these questions together.


- Do digital devices (phones, tablets, TV) ever keep us from getting enough sleep?


