The District 57 Administration, School Board and schools make it a top priority to communicate with families and community members. There is regular outreach about school news and events, as well as issues affecting your children's education, such as finances, curriculum and technology. Please take advantage of the many opportunities to be informed:

- <u>District and School Websites:</u> Go to <u>www.d57.org</u> for news, resources and links to the school sites, staff directories, calendars and more. The redesigned websites have a fresh, new design and expanded information.
- <u>District 57 App:</u> The new app is a free resource that gives you quick-and-easy access to the District and your child's school. Get it at the <u>App Store</u> or on <u>Google Play</u>.
- <u>Social Media:</u> Follow District 57 on <u>Facebook</u> and <u>Twitter</u> (@Dist57) if you haven't already done so, and regularly check the pages. District 57 social media is a hub of news, information and photos from the District and schools. You'll also find each of the schools on Twitter and Instagram.
- <u>Superintendent's Messages:</u> Updates on important issues that are distributed periodically by Dr. Aumiller via email, school newsletters, the website and social media.
- <u>School Newsletters and Emails:</u> Newsletters are distributed by the schools via email on Fridays and found on the school websites (<u>Westbrook</u>, <u>Fairview</u>, <u>Lions Park</u>, <u>Lincoln</u>). Special announcements from the schools are emailed throughout the week, if needed.
- <u>District 57 Newsletters:</u> Distributed at least twice a year via email, school newsletters, the website and social media. The fall/winter and spring/summer issues cover major news from the District and highlight exciting happenings at the schools.
- <u>School Messenger Phone System:</u> Parents will receive messages via this system when there are school closings or other urgent announcements. Email, the website and social media also will be used in these instances. Be sure to inform your school of any phone or email changes.
- <u>Bus Bulletin</u>: A system that will notify parents via text, email or voice message if their child's bus is delayed. Register online for free.
- <u>School Board:</u> Meetings are generally held at 7 p.m. on the third Thursday of the month at Fairview School. Meeting dates and topics are communicated in advance on the website and social media, and agendas/meeting packets can be found at this <u>link</u>. Community members are welcome to attend Board meetings, and there is time for public comments. Podcasts of the meetings are available at this <u>link</u>. In addition, community members can submit comments/questions for Board members at this <u>link</u>.
